Empowering Primary Healthcare in Rheumatology & Allergy

The focus of the 22nd ChanRe Update is to provide primary care physicians an insight into the latest advancements in therapeutics related to Rheumatology & Allergy

Rheumatological diseases and allergic disorders are among the most common non-communicable diseases, accounting for over 15% of the global disease burden. However, only about 2% of these cases may require specialty care and need to be managed at secondary or tertiary care levels. In primary care practice, these conditions are frequently encountered among patients attending regular outpatient clinics. On an average, primary care providers encounter 5 to 10 such cases per month in a clinic with a daily outpatient load of 40 patients. With the increasing potential avenues and diverse approaches to managing allergies, regular updates are paramount. It is essential to empower primary care physicians to manage these conditions more effectively and coordinate with secondary care specialists for the care for complex cases.

Targeted synthetic disease-modifying antirheumatic drugs (tsDMARDs) and Biologics have revolutionized the treatment landscape for autoimmune rheumatic diseases. The first lecture aims to provide guidance on the appropriate integration of these treatments into the therapeutic armamentarium. Additionally, strategies for the early identification of pulmonary and renal involvement in autoimmune rheumatic diseases will be discussed.

The session will further explore systemic lupus erythematosus (SLE) through a graded treatment approach, emphasizing individualized care for its diverse manifestations.

Vasculitis, a condition that ranges from mild to life-threatening, will be examined to better understand its spectrum and management.

Subsequent discussions in the second session will cover the evaluation of IgE-mediated allergies, identification of allergens, optimal testing methods with their utility and limitations. Allergies and their management through immunotherapy will be highlighted, with a focus on current applications and future directions.

Expanding the management of autoimmune diseases, the program also involves important primary healthcare aspect, such as the reproductive health of patients with autoimmune diseases, emphasizing safety and precautions during conception.

Recent developments in the diagnostic specialty related to skin biopsies has seen different aspects helping as a diagnostic tool for Rheumatology & Autoimmunity. The newer developments in the recent decade will be highlighted.

The post lunch session will have engaging case discussions to highlight the different aspects relating to empowering primary healthcare in Rheumatology & Allergy.

The lectures and case discussions are designed to provide valuable insights for enhancing patient management skills and deepening knowledge of strategies to navigate the complexities of autoimmune diseases and allergic disorders
